1. **acquittal** - n. the state of being found not guilty
2. **addict** - n. and v. a person who depends on something such as a drug that is usually harmful and cannot be easily given up.
3. **assent** - v. to give one's consent; to agree; n. an act of agreeing or acceptance.
4. **illustrious** - v. very famous; outstanding.
5. **immunity** - n. freedom from punishment or harm or loss
6. **incorrigible** - adj. not capable of being cured or reformed
7. **irreparable** - adj. not capable of being repaired or regained or undone
8. **miscellaneous** - adj. consisting of many things of different sorts
9. **mottled** - adj. marked with different colored patches or blotches.
10. **occurrence** - n. something that happens
11. **prowess** - n. 1 great skill or ability 2 exceptional strength courage or ability in battle
12. **riddle** - n. a puzzling question problem; something hard to understand or explain
13. **ruthless** - adj. without mercy or pity
14. **succumb** - v. to give up and cease resistance
15. **surveillance** - n. supervision or inspection
