1. **administer** - v. supervise or be in charge of; give or apply medications; direct the taking of
2. **admonished** - v. 1 to warn; 2 to criticize gently
3. **congested** - v. to fill to excess; overcrowd; clog
4. **dither** - n. a state of discomposure v. to be nervously excited or confused
5. **dwindled** - v. to diminish or become less
6. **exonerate** - v. to free from a charge of wrongdoing
7. **fluctuate** - v. to be constantly changing especially up and down
8. **homage** - n. respect or reverence paid or rendered
9. **infatuated** - v. filled with an intense or excessive love for
10. **insulate** - v. to cover with a material that keeps electricity heat or sound from escaping
11. **pander** - v. to give or promise what is wanted in order to please someone.
12. **participate** - v. to take a share or part
13. **plucked** - v. to pull or pick off or out
14. **renovate** - v. to put into good shape or working order again
15. **unscathed** - adj. completely unharmed or not injured
