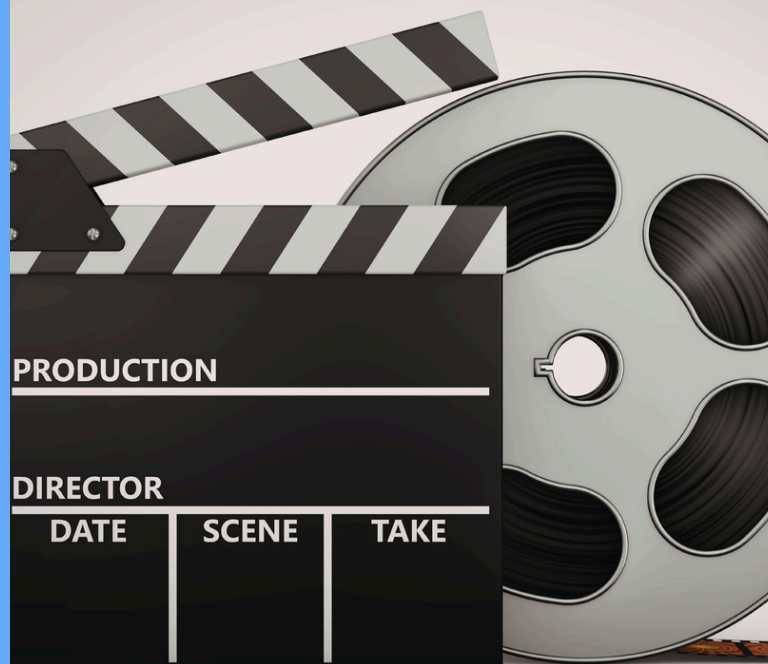

A list of vocabulary words with their definitions.

- 1. canny** - adj. careful and shrewd in one's actions and dealings
- 2. capricious** - adj. likely to change quickly for no obvious reason
- 3. chaotic** - adj. lacking in order and neatness and often cleanliness
- 4. dispatch** - v. to send off to a particular place or for a particular purpose; n. a message sent with speed such as a news bulletin.
- 5. figment** - n. a conception or image created by the imagination and having no objective reality
- 6. hurtle** - v. to move swiftly and forcefully
- 7. murmur** - n. a low and faint and continuous sound v. to express dissatisfaction or pain or resentment usually tiresomely
- 8. nimble** - adj. quick and light in movement; moving with ease; agile; active; rapid; quick to understand think devise
- 9. perturb** - v. to trouble the mind of; to make uneasy
- 10. sleek** - adj. 1 smooth and glossy 2 having slender graceful lines; healthy and well fed.
- 11. sleuth** - n. a person whose business is solving crimes and catching criminals or gathering information that is not easy to get
- 12. solitude** - n. the condition of living or being by oneself; remoteness from habitations as of a place; absence of human activity
- 13. subside** - v. 1 to sink to a lower level; 2. to become quieter or less active.
- 14. trek** - n. a long slow and difficult journey v. to travel slowly and with difficulty.
- 15. whim** - n. a sudden desire; an odd or fanciful idea
